## What are the main criteria for receiving a scholarship?

- intellectual ability and leadership potential
- a good degree (at least equivalent to upper 2<sup>nd</sup> class) from a recognised university
- apply by the deadline and gain admission to the University of Cambridge
- a high level of English language skill
- intention to return to home country after study at Cambridge

#### What will the scholarship pay?

- tuition fees, College fee, annual stipend (sufficient for a single person), return airfare
- Open Society Foundations also invite all successful applicants to a pre-academic Summer School
